## 2. Baasha of Israel

destroys the dynasty of Jeroboam, but persists in Jeroboam's sin 1 Kings 15:25–16:7.

## 3. Ahab of Israel

installs Baal as Israel's chief God 1 Kings 16:29–34.

## 4. a. Jehu of Israel

destroys the royal house of Ahab *2 Kings 9–10.* 

#### b. Athaliah

destroys all the royal house of Judah, except one little boy 2 Kings 11.

## 5. a. Ahaz of Judah

cuts off the borders of the bases of the lavers; takes down the Sea off the oxen, and puts it on the pavement 2 Kings 16:17.

## b. Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon

smashes the Sea and the pillars and takes the copper to Babylon 2 Kings 25:13.
